# Try these ways to sprinkle number knowledge into your days:

•Name numbers. Just like letters, numbers have shapes and names. When you see one, point it out, and say its name. You might show it with your fingers or indicate if it's big or small with gestures.

- Count often. We can count anything and everything: shoes on our feet, cars in the street, people we see, even some of the hairs on our heads! That's four things right there!
- •Parts of a whole. Talking about pieces of a whole can help kids understand that numbers tell the amount of something. When getting dressed, you might count how many pieces of clothing are in your outfit: a shirt, shorts, socks, and shoes means four pieces of clothing make up his/her outfit.

Children whose parents participated the program showed higher rates of growth on **Teaching Strategies Gold Language Domain.** The curriculum uses children's books and adult poems and narratives to teach literacy promoting skills to adults. Each lesson in the 29 lesson curriculum includes a variety of ways to develop parents and children's literacy skills
