# **Childcare Read**

4-hour workshop provides certification for people who work directly with children 0-5 years old.

In this training you will gain ideas and strategies to energize story time, make reading fun, and expand literacy into other parts of the childcare day. You will participate in Sample lessons from the Story Exploring® curriculum and learn the step-by-step model for planning the use of books with young children.

Each story in the high-quality, multicultural children's literature includes activities for active participation and a parent page to send home (in English and Spanish) to help to engage parents in the fun and to reinforce learning. Childcare Read has been recognized by the Colorado Department of Education as supporting Colorado's Competencies for Early Childhood Educators and Professionals and meeting best practice standards for adult learning.

Upon completion of the required objectives, each facilitator will receive an infant/toddler and preschool curriculum, several children's literature books to share with children, and qualify for 4 training hours in CDE's Colorado Shines point system.

#### **Learning Through the Senses**

From the moment they're born, kids are little scientists, constantly observing and interacting with the world around them. Using their five senses (sight, smell, touch, taste, and hearing), they gather information about their surroundings and learn from it. Consider these activities to help kids explore and learn through their senses:

- **Soap Sensation:** Use bath time to learn and experiment using the senses! Lather kids with soap and watch bubbly suds form. Invite them to feel the wet, slippery sensation against their skin, and observe the bubbles—are they big or small, transparent (clear) or opaque (cloudy)?
- Pot and Pan Band: Take out a pot, pan, and spoon. Together, experiment with sound by creating your own musical rhythm! Listen as you drum softly and then loudly with the spoon or with your hand! Notice the different sounds the pot and pan make.
- Fruity Discovery: Snack time is a great time to exercise those taste buds! Give kids small pieces of fruit (such as bananas and apples) and invite them to smell each fruit before tasting it. Compare the sweet taste and mushy texture of the banana to the tart taste, and crunchy texture of the apple.
