
Month of Giving











"Antelope"

- * They are not actually an Antelope, they are technically a Pronghorn Deer. Their closest relatives are: <u>giraffes</u> and <u>okapi</u>, (both of Africa), <u>deer</u>, <u>bovids</u>, and <u>moschids</u>
- They are the fastest land mammal in the Western Hemisphere and can run from approximately 35 mph to 55 mph, depending on the distance. The only animal that is faster is the cheetah.
- Major predators include: cougars, wolves, coyotes, grizzly bears, bobcats, golden eagles, and people.
- * They have a gestation period of 7-8 months. They breed in mid-September, and birth in late May. They typically give birth to twins.
- Sexual maturity is reached at 15-16 months, though males rarely breed until three years old.
- * Lifespan is typically up to 10 years, and occasionally can reach 15.
- * Fawns are almost odorless at birth to help protect them from predators. They start to graze at three weeks old, and can run faster than a human at four days old.
- * They eat grasses, forbs, cactus, sagebrush, and other available plants.
- * They migrate 150 miles each way between seasons. The only other land animal to travel farther in North America is the caribou.
- They are only found in North America and their range extends from southern Canada to northern Mexico, but are mainly found in the Great Plains, Wyoming, Montana, northeast California, southeast Oregon, Nevada, Utah, Colorado, Arizona, and New Mexico.
